Scholarship Descriptions

American Veterans (AMVETS) Scholarships

AMVETS Spouse Scholarship

<u>What:</u> Scholarships designed to fulfill a financial gap after all Federal/State grants and/or scholarships available to an eligible applicant have been exhausted.

<u>Who:</u> Spouses of an Honorably/General Under Honorable Conditions discharged United States Veteran or Active Military member to include National Guard and Reserves. The candidate must be a U.S. Citizen enrolled in an eligible undergraduate degree program at an accredited four (4) year college or university. The candidate must demonstrate financial need and must not be in default on a federal student loan.

Application Window: January 1, 2026 – April 30, 2026

AMVETS Children/Grandchildren Scholarship

<u>What:</u> Scholarships designed to fulfill a financial gap after all Federal/State grants and/or scholarships available to an eligible applicant have been exhausted.

<u>Who:</u> Children/grandchildren of an Honorably/General Under Honorable Conditions discharged United States Veteran or Active Military member to include National Guard and Reserves. The candidate must be a U.S. Citizen currently in 12th grade, entering college in the Fall, and demonstrating financial need. Candidates must be accepted into an eligible undergraduate degree program at an accredited four (4) year college or university.

Application Window: January 1, 2026 – April 30, 2026

Chief Petty Officers & Enlisted Association Scholarships

Captain Caliendo College Assistance Fund (CCCAF)

What: Total of five scholarships ranging from \$1,500 to \$5,000

Fisher House Scholarships for Military Children Program

What: Total of 500 scholarship grants each for \$2,000

Who: Unmarried military dependent children under the age 23 who possess a valid Uniformed Services Identification (USID) card. The student's parent(s)/sponsor(s) must be active duty, reserve/guard, deceased, or retired from the Army, Marine Corps, Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard, or Space Force. Must be enrolled or planning to enroll in a full-time undergraduate program leading to a bachelor's degree or a community/junior college designed to allow for a direct transfer into a four-year program. High school applicants must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 (on a 4.0 basis). College applicants must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5. College freshmen must submit a first-semester college transcript.
